He then began to threaten her saying he was going to come to her work and beat her ass and slit the tires on her car.

The suspect did show up at her work and came inside the business. She was hiding in the back break room with the door locked. He bought some cookies and asked the manager where was Beth. The manager did not reply. The suspect then went to the break room and attempted to gain entry into the room. Beth was on the phone with 911 at the time and he fled the area prior to our arrival.

Beth states he has destroyed the house while on these Meth binges. She also states he held her inside the house against her will for several days about a month ago.

I spoke with her about going to a shelter but she wants to get a protective order and stay at home with her kids. I followed her to the courts building and she is going to start that process.

Due to the suspect being a Felony DV candidate and the previous cases between these two I forwarded this case to the DV unit.
