resuscitation attempts. When I arrived on scene, the garage door was open and the VI was lying on the ground, face down, next to a generator. The generator was off and an unplugged extension cord lying next to it.

I first spoke with the VI's live in girlfriend, Kendra (IO#1). Kendra advised that she and the VI entered into a verbal argument this morning around 0500 hrs. The VI was upset over a relationship that had fostered between his best friend and Kendra while he was in jail. The verbal argument escalated, where the VI then grabbed a large amount of Methamphetamine, smoked a large bowl and "shot up" the rest with a syringe. The VI told Kendra that he's going to the garage and hopes she finds him dead on the floor, then stormed out of the house. Kendra stated she was tired and went to bed.

At approximately 1200 hrs., Kendra woke up and tried to find the VI. When Kendra went out to the garage, all the doors and windows were locked. Kendra then called a friend, Omar (IO#2), briefed him as to what occurred, and asked if he would come over to help. Omar agreed and brought Karen (RP) with him. Karen is a close friend to Omar. Once Omar and Karen arrived, they assisted and were able to lift the garage door up about a foot. Karen lied down on the ground and was able to scoot under the door. Once inside, Karen opened the side door and let everyone else in. That's when they found the VI lying on the floor and unresponsive. Karen then called 911.
