When it was time to check out, the OF's asked the motel clerk, Rebecca, if they could hold the room for them while they tried to secure more money to pay for it. Rebecca advised they could not and they would need to pay for the room. The OF's stated they understood and left. However, the OF's left all their clothes and a printing machine in the room. I asked Jatin if the OF's still had any legal rights to the room, in which he replied no, they have checked out and have not paid anything to keep the room in their name. Jatin then asked if I wanted to see the room and the contents inside. I was escorted to room 102 and Jatin keyed us in. Inside the room were several articles of clothing, a printer, and a file container. Inside the file container, were hundreds of blank checks and two counterfeit money sheets. I then called for a bunco detective and crime scene.</p> <p>During this, Joyce arrived from Warrick County to speak with me about the active case she has against the two OF's. Her case number in Warrick County is 17-03590. Joyce said that on Wednesday morning, 12/06/17, the Newburgh Old National Bank called her, stating their security department advised them, that someone was writing fraudulent checks on Rivertown Construction's account. When the bank official informed Joyce of the account number they were using, she told the bank that that was their "account's payable" account number, not their payroll account. Once Joyce learned who the checks were made out to, she told me that Chad's (OF#2) father used to work for them, which may be why Chad is using their company.</p> <p>Once Crime Scene arrived, they began processing the scene.
