Officers responded to a 911 hang up at the listed address. It was an open line and dispatch advised they could hear a male in the background screaming and yelling, calling someone a "whore". Dispatch added that it sounded like someone else whispered, "hostage".

When officers arrived on scene, we were met by the victim and homeowner, Sharla. Officers began interviewing Sharla and during this, a black male, later identified as Irvin (WI#1), and a white female, later identified as Norma (WI#2), were sitting on a couch in the living room, pointing to the front room. I then asked everyone to vacate the house and passed Irvin and Norma off to Dep. Dimmitt who was also assisting. Sharla resisted officers at first and did not want to leave the house, for fear of her dogs and cats getting loose. I then asked Sharla to quickly exit the house and asked if anyone else was home. Sharla slowly walked toward the side door and stated, "no, no one else is inside." Irvin and Norma reiterated that they know he is in the front room, because they watched him walk in with the dogs. Moreover, where they were sitting, there was no way for him to make it to the back of the house without them seeing him. Officers asked who "him" was, in which they replied they did not know his name, but advised the guy was Sharla's boyfriend and she has a restraining order against him. Again, Sharla stated that Irvin and Norma were lying and that no one else was inside her house. Sharla also stated that she had dropped the order.

I then called our central records office to see if an active order was still in place. Records was able to confirm that the order was still in force and that the guy's name was Clarence (OF). Cause number 82D06-PO-002720. Officers asked Sharla if she could put the dogs up, so we can search that bedroom. Sharla stated that she didn't want to do that, citing that her dogs are vicious and if they get out, will bite. I asked if that's why Clarence ran into that room, in which eventually, Sharla admitted that Clarence was in the house and yes, that's why he ran into that room. Sharla then advised officers that she wasn't the one who put the restraining order on Clarence. Sharla stated it was her mother who did it, because her mother has power of attorney over her. Sharla continued telling officers she was fine, it was Clarence and Norma who got into an argument, and was completely uncooperative. Sharla did not want us searching her home either. I asked Sharla if she was in fear for her life, safety, or well being, in which she replied no. I asked Sharla if we were to leave, would she feel safe around Clarence, in which she stated yes.

I then called Sgt. Motz, briefed him as to what I had, and per his recommendation, took a report, left the premises, and advised the VI this was her last chance for help before we leave. Sharla stated she understood and would be fine. Officers then approached Irvin and Norma of the same and requested they leave for their own safety, in which they agreed.
