Sharla slowly walked toward the side door and stated, "no, no one else is inside." Irvin and Norma reiterated that they know he is in the front room, because they watched him walk in with the dogs. Moreover, where they were sitting, there was no way for him to make it to the back of the house without them seeing him. Officers asked who "him" was, in which they replied they did not know his name, but advised the guy was Sharla's boyfriend and she has a restraining order against him. Again, Sharla stated that Irvin and Norma were lying and that no one else was inside her house. Sharla also stated that she had dropped the order.</p> <p>I then called our central records office to see if an active order was still in place. Records was able to confirm that the order was still in force and that the guy's name was Clarence (OF). Cause number 82D06-PO-002720. Officers asked Sharla if she could put the dogs up, so we can search that bedroom. Sharla stated that she didn't want to do that, citing that her dogs are vicious and if they get out, will bite.
