Shortly after the vehicle was towed from the scene, dispatch advised officers that Tevin Woodruff would like to speak with an officer via phone. Woodruff was called and he advised that he had bought the car from Robertson and had a title to the vehicle. Officers arrived at Woodruff's address at 731 E Delaware.
