After speaking with the victim, it was found that the incident occurred at Franklin Street Tavern at 2126 W Franklin St. The victim stated that she is a Lyft driver and got a run from the tavern for a Brandi. She arrived to find the female with another female and 2 males wanting a ride. As the parties began to get into the car, a white male wearing and orange coat began to argue with the male that was getting into the front passenger door. The altercation became physical with the male in orange pushing the other. They came in contact with the right rear passenger door. At this time, the victim said she pepper sprayed the male in the orange. The 3 original parties got into the car and told the victim to drive off. She started to leave when 2 white males, including the one in orange ran after the car and punched it a few times. The victim stopped the car and got out to confront them. The 2 males pushed her, so she got back into the car and made the other people exit the vehicle. She then cancelled the ride and went home.</p> <p>I observed a small scratch to the paint on the right rear door of the car. I saw no other damage caused by this incident. The victim had no visible injuries from the males pushing her.</p> <p>The victim of the battery is not the registered owner of the car. The victim of the criminal mischief is listed separately.</p> <p>The victim was given the case number. I suggested reaching out to Lyft to see if she could get the full name of the female who requested the ride.
