The Female was highly intoxicated and stated she thought her husband was cheating on her and an argument began over that. She stated that nothing physical had happened other than what we saw and that was just a show put on by her husband so we'd think she was crazy. The husband stated he had just returned back to the room from the hospital where he works. He was still in scrubs but his wife was intoxicated when he returned and accused him of cheating on her. He stated to avoid any conflict he packed his suitcase and attempted to leave. He said his wife grabbed his suitcase and the knife and started stabbing the suitcase. He said she never at any time threatened him or herself with the knife but he was worried about where things could be headed. He stated he was able to get the knife from her and then held her down while he yelled for help. Once we arrived he was cooperative and followed all commands. He gathered his belongings and went to a different hotel for the night to let things cool down.</p> <p>There were no injuries to either subject and both denied anything physical happened other than the male stating he took the knife away from his wife and held her until we arrived. The wife denied this ever happened though and that she ever had the knife. The female was asked if she had any intentions now or at anytime tonight to hurt herself and she said she did not.
