She stated that she said to the male she needed space. The male became angry and grabbed her phone, she attempted to get it back when he "swung on her" causing an abrasion to her left eye. She said she may have scratched him during the fight. She stated he then pushed her on the couch and hit her with his elbow, but had no injury related to it. She said he then left the residence with all of his belongings. She told officers he does not live with her and they have only been dating for a little while, but have both been physical with each other. Neither parties wanted to press charges and only wanted to separate for the night. Both individuals were given information on how to pursue a protective order and advised of their rights as victims.
