The RP told officers that when her ex-husband returned the kids, their oldest daughter, who is eighteen, wasn't with them. The RP stated that her son told her that the oldest daughter went to her boyfriends house to have dinner with his family. The RP told officers that she tried calling her eighteen year old daughter to tell her to be home by eight, and her daughter said "fuck you, bitch" and hung up the phone.</p> <p>The RP told me that her ex-husband had no legal right to let his eighteen year old daughter go to her boyfriend's house, and that he was required by law to go pick up the RP's eighteen year old daughter and bring her to the RP's home. The RP then showed me custody paperwork (82D05-1108-DR-796), which stated nothing of the sort. The paperwork advised that the RP had custody and that she and the ex-husband would follow the parenting time guidelines.</p> <p>I also spoke to the ex-husband. The ex-husband stated that the RP never told him that she wanted the oldest daughter home by eight, so he had no problem with letting her go to her boyfriend's house. He stated that his daughter's boyfriend picked her up earlier. The ex-husband told me that the RP and their oldest daughter don't get along very well, and he always gets thrown into the middle.</p> <p>The homeowner (ex-husband's father) stated that he didn't want the RP showing up unannounced, asked that I bar/ban the RP from his address. When I informed the RP that she was barred from the property, she told me that she would stand on the street if she wanted to because it was public property. The RP then demanded a case report; she was given a case number.</p> <p>The RP then told me I had to make her ex-husband go pick up her eighteen year old daughter and bring her to the RP's house. I explained to her that her daughter was eighteen and that I couldn't make her ex-husband go get her, and that if she wanted her then she would have to go get her herself.
