would and told me that his phone was dead anyway.

I then called Victoria and she sounded extremely upset and distraught about the dog and told me she had recordings of Beau beating the animal. I offered to meet her and listen to the recordings.

When I met with Victoria, she showed me a chain of text messages in which a person labeled as "husband" on her phone is trying to get Victoria to come over and get her stuff. There were several messages back and forth between "husband" and Victoria about coming over, property, and the dog; however, there was no time stamp on the messages that would allow me to verify when they had been sent. Victoria was unable to find the recording of Beau with the dog yelping in the background.

I explained to Victoria that Indiana is a community property state where marriage is concerned and that pets fall under the category of livestock and are considered part of the property of the marriage. I further explained that Beau telling her he was going to take the dog to the shelter was legal especially since he conveyed to me that he could not take care of the animal.

As I was speaking to Victoria, Beau called her phone. I asked her to answer it on speaker. When she answered, I recognized Beau's voice. Beau stated that he was going to burn Victoria's daughter's clothes and send her a video if Victoria did not come over. Victoria protested that she was not going to come over to do drugs with him, at which point he said that he would find someone else to.

After their conversation and based on the threat to burn the daughter's clothing, I decide to complete a harassment report. I gave Victoria the case # and advised her to get a copy to take with her to a protective order hearing she has scheduled for later in the week. I also advised Victoria to text Beau telling him that she did not want to talk to him any more and to stop texting her. Victoria did this as I was standing there. I advised Victoria to not answer any calls or respond to any texts from that point on and it could be considered harassment. I advised her that if she did answer, it could be a conversation.
