Hyundai Santa Fe, and left South toward Virginia St. She said the vehicle was parked in front of the store with her 15 year old son in the passenger seat, waiting for her to finish shopping. Her son said the suspect opened the driver's side door to the vehicle before he noticed someone was inside it. He apologized to the juvenile, closed the door and walked away. The juvenile said he locked the car doors after that, but a minute or so later, the suspect returned to the vehicle and knocked on the window of the driver's door. The juvenile could not roll that window down from his side of the car, so he unlocked the doors. That's when the suspect opened the driver's door again. This time he had his hand concealed in his coat pocket and told the juvenile, "Get the fuck out, I have a gun." The juvenile immediately exited the vehicle from the passenger side, and ran into Shoe Carnival where he notifed his mother.

An officer in the area located the stolen vehicle traveling West on the Lloyd. He followed it to Weinbach, where it pulled into the Family Dollar parking lot. The driver did not exit the vehicle, and quickly pulled back onto Weinbach. At that point, the vehicle began to flee from the officer, who activated his emergency lights and sirens. The vehicle pursuit that ensued went North on 41 past Saint George, and then came back South on 41 to Columbia. As the stolen vehicle turned West on Columbia from 41, it collided with an unmarked police unit. The stolen vehicle continued West on Columbia, and eventually the suspect exited the vehicle going the wrong way on Governor at Delaware. The stolen vehicle was not put in park though, and after the suspect got out, it continued North until it struck a parked car. The suspect laid down on the ground after exiting the vehicle, and was taken into custody. No firearm was located in the stolen car or on the suspect. It was towed to Tri State at the owner's request.
