K. (C), at 1479 W Maryland St/n Seventh Ave, Evansville, IN, between 22:30, Traffic-accident 02/02/2019 and 23:00, 02/02/2019. Reported: 02/03/2019. Hit&run /prop [bm]Listed Victim, Mr Gibson, advises that sometime between 22:30 and 23:00 hours last night, the family dogs were "going insane" at his home at 1424 W MARYLAND ST. Even though he did not hear anything himself, Mr Gibson looked outside in time to see a red car backing Southbound back onto MARYLAND ST, from the vacant grassy lot to his home's West. The driver was a black male in his late 20s. The red car was last seen Eastbound on MARYLAND ST. Mr Gibson did not think much more about it and returned to bed. This morning, he discovered that his Dodge Dakota (listed Vehicle 1)--which was parked on the vacant lot next to his home with the lot owner's permission--had been hit. The Dodge had been sitting on the grass lot, facing East. The driver's side center and the driver's door are now damaged. The Dodge had been moved sideways, to the south, approximately two feet. Mr Gibson realized that this was why the dogs were reacting the previous night and he had seen the other vehicle driving away. Around noon, Mr Gibson located a red Chevy Cruze, approximately three blocks away to the Southgeast, at FIFTH AVE and COLUMBIA. The Cruze (listed Vehicle 2) appeared to be the same vehicle that he had seen drive away from the lot next to his home. The Cruze also had fresh damage to the front. Mr Gibson called Police. It appears that the Cruze was Southbound on SEVENTH AVE and failed to stop or turn at the offset intersection with MARYLAND ST. The Cruze then went across the curb on the South side of MARYLAND ST, onto the grassy lot and the front end of the Cruze struck the driver's side of the unoccupied Dodge Dakota. The driver then left the scene, still in the Cruze East on MARYLAND ST, without providing mandatory information. At this time, the driver is unknown as is the insurance information on the Cruze. The Cruze is registered to listed OW. At the time of this report, OW has active felony warrant for her arrest.
