This afternoon, his stepson returned to the residence an claimed an acquaintance of his stole the victim's vehicle. The story his stepson told him did not make sense, so officers requested to speak with him.

The stepson was an adult and officers spoke with him. The stepson reported his cellular phone had been taken last evening by another acquaintance of his, identified as an involved other, while they were at the Corner Pocket, which is why he was unable to respond to his stepfather's text messages. However, he stayed the evening with the individual and had possession of his cellular phone when he returned home. This morning, the stepson allowed one of the acquaintances to drive the vehicle and they picked-up the other acquaintance at his residence on the west side of Evansville. They returned to 1112 Georgia Street and the offender was able to get the keys from the other acquaintance. The stepson observed the other acquaintance take the vehicle without permission and for no reason. The stepson stated the offender knew the vehicle belonged to him, technically his stepfather, and did not have permission to take it.

Officers had a long conversation with the victim once more and he requested to pursue charges against the offender for stealing his vehicle.

The victim was provided a case number and a report was submitted to the EPD Auto Theft Unit for follow-up. The vehicle will be placed into NCIC as stolen and the victim was advised to call if he located the vehicle before it was recovered by law enforcement. As of this report, no arrest has been made.
