Officers arrived on scene and spoke with the caller, identified as the victim. She reported approximately \$152.00 U.S. currency was missing from an envelope within her residence. She last knew the money was in her residence the day prior, 05/06/2019. She noticed the money was missing this morning, around 09:00 hours, and notified management. She and management reviewed surveillance footage and observed a black male enter her residence yesterday around 11:45 hours after she exited the residence some time earlier. She recognized the black male and stated he was the boyfriend of a friend of her's, who also lived within the building. She stated she allowed them to keep a spare key to their apartment within her home in the chance they accidentally locked themselves out of their apartment. The victim reported always leaving her apartment unlocked when she would leave her apartment and stated this had happened before.

Officers spoke with management and observed the same surveillance footage outlined above. Officers located the black male, identified as the suspected offender, and spoke with him outside of the building. He was read his Miranda Rights, which he stated he understood, and agreed to speak with officers. The suspect acknowledged he had entered the victim's residence yesterday in order to get the spare key because he had been locked out of his residence. He denied taking any money and stated he had always been allowed to enter the residence in the past to get the key.
