paperwork into the office he might have been working for Thunderbolt Pass. However he never did so he was not an employee.

Sunday the staff noticed a water pump, a couple of chain saws, a pole saw and a weed eater missing. When they noticed the items missing on Sunday another employee stated when he came into work on Thursday the latch was hanging on the large sliding door.

The shop is a green and white pole barn with two large sliding doors that meet in the middle. It is latched in the center and there is a brace at the bottom to keep it from being pulled out away from the building.

On the sides of the door near the building they have installed latches. These latches keep the door up tight against the building. This prevents somebody from pulling the door out away from the building and gaining access.

It appears the suspect took a crowbar and wedged it between the door and building. Once he was able to get the crowbar in between he pulled up on the crowbar and was able to get the latch unhooked.

Since this incident they have replaced the latch.

When Mr. Wells learned of the items taken he immediately thought of the suspect. Mr. Walls text the suspect and questioned him about the items. The suspect agreed to bring the items back.

The suspect only brought back the pole saw and a weed eater. All of the other items are still missing. When Mr. Walls text him about the other items, the suspect then tried to deny doing it.
