The suspected offender then started to violently grab his ex-girlfriend by her hair, to which she stated she had a complaint of a headache. The suspected offender and his ex-girlfriend eventually left the residence and started to part ways. This is when the ex-girlfriend stated he began to grab her violently again and pull her to the vehicle he was going to be leaving in. A brief struggle ensued and the other victim attempted to separate the two. The suspected offender then turned his anger toward the second victim and with closed fist struck her multiple times in the head and face area. After a brief altercation the suspected offender took off on foot prior to Officers arriving. Both the victims stated that the offender had a ride waiting on him to take him back to his mother's residence on the far east side of town. The victims also stated that the driver of the vehicle was his brother and the two were headed back to their mother's residence. Officers observed multiple laceration to the second victims face along with blood emitting from her mouth. Both victims refused AMR and crime scene was requested for photos.
