On 07/18/2019, at approximately 13:55 hours, the Evansville Police Department (EPD) was requested near the intersection of E Louisiana Street / Elsas Avenue in reference to a motor vehicle accident with injuries. The caller reported a male was passed out inside of the vehicle.

Officers arrived on scene and observed the Evansville Fire Department (EFD) assisting a male driver, identified as the offender Thomas Thompson, seated inside of a gray 2007 Ford Mustang. AMR # 4122 arrived a short time later to assist, but Thomas refused medical attention.

While medical personnel assisted Thomas, officers spoke with witnesses and they reported Thomas' vehicle was traveling east on E Louisiana Street at somewhat of a slow speed. They reported his vehicle slammed into a red 1977 Ford F600 dump truck, which was parked, facing east, on E Louisiana Street. Following the collision, they approached Thomas' vehicle and observed him passed out behind the wheel.

After medical staff attended to Thomas, officers spoke with him and he appeared somewhat dazed and was sweating profusely. They asked him if he had taken anything prior to the accident, he reported he had not, other than Benadryl earlier in the morning. Thomas stated it was not normal for him to pass out and officers explained he should have gone to the hospital. He understood and stated he wanted to go after they were finished. Thomas stated he did not have insurance coverage, it had lapsed.

Thomas' vehicle sustained heavy front end damage, initially impacting the front right side. It was towed by Tri-State Towing to their yard, located at 1501 N Evans Avenue. While conducting an inventory of the vehicle, officers located a clear baggy containing a green leafy substance, believed to be marijuana, in the center console.

Officers spoke with Thomas, read him his Miranda Rights Warning and spoke with him about what they had located. They asked him again if he had taken anything and he denied. When they explained what they had located, he admitted the substance would test positive for marijuana and he had smoked it moments before the accident occurred. Officers read Thomas his Implied Consent Warning and he agreed to a chemical test.

Thomas was transported to Deaconess Hospital Emergency Room to be evaluated and to complete an Indiana State Police Blood Kit. Prior to being evaluated at the hospital, Thomas agreed to standard field sobriety tests (SFST). Thomas failed two of three tests.

Given the totality of the circumstances, witness statements, Thomas' statements and the narcotics located inside of the vehicle, officers had probable cause to believe Thomas likely operated a motor vehicle while impaired. Additionally, there were pedestrians and other occupied motor vehicles nearby when Thomas wrecked as a result of his impairment. After being medically cleared, Thomas was arrested and booked into the Vanderburgh County Confinement Center for
