		Officers finally located the above neighbor and learned the offender was her child's paternal grandmother. The neighbor stated the victim's fiancee attempted to have an affair with her while he and the victim were having issues. At some point, the victim located messages between her fiancee and the neighbor and confronted her. She stated an affair never occurred, but reported the victim's fiancee tried. She understood why the victim would be upset given the circumstances.

The neighbor reported she attempted to use the community laundry building and had to walk near the victim's residence to do so. As she did so, she reported the victim and some additional residents said derogatory things toward her and stated, "It would be in your best interest..." She took the victim's statements as a threat and told her child's father, who told his mother, the offender. Officers asked the neighbor to call the offender through social media and she answered. Officers spoke with the offender asked what had happened. She reported she was advised by her son the victim and others were going to "jump on", assault, her grandchild's mother. She stated she was not going to have it and would fight anyone if they tried to do so, whether she would go to jail or not. She stated it was only a misdemeanor and would have no issues dealing with it. Officers explained to her some of the threats she made through social media could be a felony if they had been made toward specific people and she advised she was not aware of that. Officers further explained the situation to her and she understood why the victim would be upset, but also reiterated she would not accept her grandchild's mother being assaulted. It was explained to her any physical confrontation was doubtful and that she needed to cease with communication / threats toward the victim. She stated she would do so and had blocked the victim on social media. She was advised the victim would be told to calm down as well.

Officers returned and spoke with the victim. She was advised what the neighbor and offender had claimed and she acknowledged she had made statements toward the neighbor because she was hurt by her actions. However, she denied threatening the neighbor. She understood how family of the neighbor would take her comments and why they would confront her. She stated she was just upset and would not make any future statements.

The victim wanted a report to make a record of the incident. She was advised how to seek a protective order against the offender. She was also advised to save screenshots of the messages for court purposes.

The offender made statements to the victim in an attempt to place her in fear by threatening to harm her and her children. She also made statements to harm the victim's fiancee, but those threats were not directly communicated to him by the offender.

A report was submitted to the EPD Misdemeanor Investigations Unit for follow-up. No arrests were made at time of report.
