located immediately adjacent to her's. While showing officers the bedroom window on the outside of the residence, the victim and officers observed a cut window screen on the daughter's bedroom window. She was not certain if it happened tonight or another night. The caller's daughter is Tyler's girlfriend / ex-girlfriend. The caller was crying and is terrified by Tyler and his actions.

Officers returned and spoke with Tyler after advising him of his rights. When asked why he went onto the property, he stated he wanted to speak with the family and primarily was looking for his girlfriend, a victim.

On several occasions in October of this year, Tyler has been encountered by law enforcement at the above residence or at another family residence in which his girlfriend / ex-girlfriend is known to stay. On a couple of other occasions, the family had called to report additional occurrences in which Tyler was observed outside of their residence. In total, a couple of the incidents had led to Tyler's arrest, including this one.

Tyler's girlfriend is currently separated from him due to violence, narcotics abuse and psychological disturbances. She noted she is pregnant with their daughter, but is fearful of Tyler and wants him to get help before reuniting with her and their daughter. She is currently living with her mother and other family.

Tyler's actions have continued to escalate and have brought stress and panic to the family, including his girlfriend / ex-girlfriend. His actions have grown more bold and to an average family would raise alarm about their safety and well-being. Some of those incidents will be noted more in detail in the arrest affidavit.

Given the totality of the circumstances, Tyler's actions not only this evening, but also over the course of October, have shown his continued disregard for the family's and victims' concerns, raising alarm and panic about their safety and well-being. On at least seven (7) instances in October, Tyler has either been in contact with law enforcement in reference to the family or the family has called to report Tyler's disturbing actions and incessant harassment. Given such, officers feel it is probable Tyler's disregard has raised to the level of stalking. Tyler was arrested, transported to the Vanderburgh County Confinement Center and charged with stalking and criminal trespass. For more information, please see affidavit of probable cause.
