The RP was not able to get a description of the driver. His Hummer was hit in the left rear tire causing it to be pushed up into the front part of the wheel well. The Suspect vehicle had heavy front end damage to the passenger side front. It was locked and the driver was not around. Officer Afifi checked the registered owners address. There were two car seats in the back of the vehicle and what appeared to be a kids sock hat laying on the ground next to it. Officer Afifi made contact with a female at that address (IO 2) who stated she knew the registered owner (IO 1). She said he had borrowed her jeep to go to work and that she didn't know anything about a Nissan Altima. Officers Afifi told her about the car seats and that he was mainly wanted to check the welfare of the kids.
