No victims listed.</p> <p>Officers were dispatched to 619 Chateau Drive for a suspicious circumstances call. Officers were informed that Evans, identified as involved other 1, was moving furniture from a window of this residence. The run card alerted officers that the property attorney of Eco Square Apartments had banned Evans from the property during Evans' 1/14/20 eviction court hearing.</p> <p>Upon arriving to the apartment complex we found various furniture items on a sidewalk outside of an apartment window around the area of apartment 619. At apartment 619, after knocking, Evans answered the door. Davis, identified as involved other 2 and Evans' girlfriend, was also at the door next to Evans. Evans was asked if he had any weapons on him to which he stated that he had a gun in the front pocket of his pants, which was removed by Officer Condiff who then made the weapon safe. Because the information relayed to us by Dispatch regarding Evans being barred from this property he was detained and placed in handcuffs. During this time Officer Afifi arrived at the residence.</p> <p>Officers explained to Evans and Davis that we were initially called due to the furniture being placed out of the window. Evans and Davis stated that they have had ongoing disputes with their neighbors upstairs, and attributed their recent eviction to these issues. We informed Evans that because he was currently barred from the property he was trespassing. Evans and Davis stated that Evans' attorney had stated that Evans had until 12:00am of 1/19/20 to remove his belongings from the apartment and vacate the property before he would be deemed as trespassing. We explained to Evans and Davis that the information we had from the recent court proceedings was that he was banned during that court date on 1/14/20. I asked Evans and Davis if they had any paperwork that stated that Evans had until 12:00am of 1/19/20 to vacate the property to which Evans stated that he had an email from the landlord stating that he had until midnight to night to be moved out of the apartment</p> <p>Officer Condiff and Afifi read the email provided by Evans. Officer Condiff contacted EPD Records staff to ask that the court proceeding paperwork be reviewed. After reviewing all of this information we were advised by records that the bar from the property was effective as of 1/19/20 and that Evans was currently in violation of that bar. Evans was placed into custody and informed that he would be transported to the Vanderburgh County Correction Center (VCCC) and charged with Trespassing. Evans and Davis continue to dispute this finding and both became increasingly disruptive.</p> <p>Upon arriving to VCCC. Evans was placed into a holding cell while myself and Officer Condiff reviewed the paperwork from the 1/14/20 court proceedings that was provided by EPD Records. After reviewing this paperwork in detail it was determined that Evans did in fact have until 12:00am on 1/19/20 to vacate the property and that the Evans was to be barred from the property AFTER 1/19/2020.</p>		HOWARD, K.
