They chased him on foot, but lost sight of him after he fled east.</p> <p>Numerous Evansville Police Department (EPD) Officers and additional VCSO Deputies arrived in the area to assist with the search for male, described as a white male and approximately 50 years of age. He was last seen wearing a hat, a black jacket and tan pants.</p> <p>Officers and deputies searched the area for some time. At approximately 09:49 hours, an EPD Officer observed a male matching the description of the above subject running north through a backyard on the east side of N Kentucky Avenue, south of E Olmstead Avenue. Officers and deputies quickly established a perimeter and the male, later identified as William Fowler, attempted to exit the perimeter between two homes as he walked east toward N New York Avenue. Fowler saw an officer, turned away and fled from the uniformed officer on foot. A foot pursuit ensued toward the west and then south. Fowler jumped several fences, traveled through several yards and was later apprehended in the 1000-block of Stanley Avenue.
