The defendant was a passenger in a vehicle during a traffic stop. The vehicle was stopped because the registration plate on the vehicle showed an date in 2014. During the stop, your affiant observed the defendant conceal an unknown item in his left front pants pocket while he was seated in the middle seat of the vehicle. It was clear by the defendant's behavior that he was attempting to conceal the item out of view of your affiant and other officers while we were focused on the other occupants. The defendant was looking over his shoulder while concealing the item in order to see if officers were focused on his movements.

Upon ordering the defendant out of the vehicle, your affiant conducted a pat down of his outer clothing for weapons. Your affiant immediately recognized what I was able to identify through training and experience as a glass pipe that is commonly used to ingest narcotics. Upon asking the defendant if there was anything sharp in his pockets, the defendant acknowledged that the item was in fact a pipe. A second clear glass tube was located in the same pocket, and it was protected by a cloth pot holder. Both pipes had burnt residue that later field tested positive for methamphetamine. These pipes are commonly used to ingest narcotics into the human body.

In addition to the paraphernalia, your affiant also located a crystalline substance that was wrapped inside of cellophane in the defendant's right front pants pocket. This substance field tested positive for methamphetamine and had a field weight of approximately 2 grams.
