As the officer became within view of the subjects, the white male (offender) quickly turned and began walking away.</p> <p>The officer initiated a stop and spoke with the subjects. The officer explained the reasoning of his stop and their suspicious behavior. The officer asked both if they had anything on them he should know about and asked if he could search their persons, which they allowed. The officer did not locate anything on the black male, but located the above cigarillo package on the white male. It felt stuffed and not like it normally would. The officer checked the contents and located a baggy containing a green leafy substance.
