The white male appeared nervous to see the officer and continued to watch the officer's response as he passed by. After the officer passed by, both males continued to turn and look for the officer. Given the officer's training and experience as a police officer, the subjects' actions, along with their body language, were suspicious and appeared the officer caught them in the midst of criminal activity. From the officer's training and experience, it is fairly common for cigarillos to be used to smoke narcotics. Many times, subjects remove the tobacco from the cigars and replace it with marijuana or a synthetic cannabinoid. The officer made a turn, briefly went out of sight and turned around to see their reaction when they saw the officer a second time. As the officer became within view of the subjects, the white male (offender) quickly turned and began walking away. The officer initiated a stop and spoke with the subjects. The officer explained the reasoning of his stop and their suspicious behavior. The officer asked both if they had anything on them he should know about and asked if he could search their persons, which they allowed. The officer did not locate anything on the black male, but located the above cigarillo package on the white male. It felt stuffed and not like it normally would. The officer checked the contents and located a baggy containing a green leafy substance. The green leafy substance field tested positive for marijuana. The white male was given a misdemeanor citation for possession of marijuana and ordered to appear in court in April 2020. Both were released and no arrests were made.
