The victim stated she was 33 weeks pregnant and the suspect was the father. She was concerned about her heart rate and requested AMR. AMR arrived and checked the victim. She refused to go to hospital with AMR.

K9 arrived to assist and attempted to track. K9 was unable to locate suspect.
