EXECUTIVE ORDER _____

DINING IN RESPONSE TO THE CORONAVIRUS DISEASE 2019 EPIDEMIC ENFORCEMENT DIRECTIVE REGARDING **PROHIBITION** IN-PERSON

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY COME, GREETINGS:

- WHEREAS. health emergency on March, 6, 2020, I issued Executive Order 20-02, which declared a public United States and worldwide; Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) outbreak in Indiana, throughout the Ħ the State of Indiana as a result of the novel (new)
- WHEREAS, national emergency; on March 13, 2020, the President of the United States declared COVID-19 to be
- WHEREAS, smaller gatherings; of the virus, including cancellation of large gatherings and social distancing in recommended implementation of mitigation strategies to increase containment and Prevention (CDC) and the Indiana State Department of Health (ISDH) have to reduce and slow the spread of COVID-19, the Centers for Disease Control
- WHEREAS, initial exposure and secondary transmission to our most vulnerable populations and are especially important for people who are over 60 years old limitations on large gatherings and social distancing measures can prevent initial exposure and secondary transmission to our most vulnerable or have chronic health conditions;
- WHEREAS, authorized to provide drive-thru, take-out and delivery services"; bars, nightclubs and other establishments providing in-dining services ... to close to in-person patrons through March 31, 2020, but these entities are on March 16, 2020, under Executive Order 20-04, I ordered all "restaurants
- WHEREAS, 20-04; allow in-dining service, notwithstanding the issuance of Executive since March 16, 2020, certain establishments have continued to provide and Order
- WHEREAS, in light of the above, it is necessary and proper to take further actions to protect and evolving threat posed to public health by COVID-19; the health, safety and welfare of all Hoosiers in connection with the continuing
- WHEREAS, as Governor, under Indiana's Emergency Management and Disaster Law, Ind. orders made under this emergency law; action and give any direction to state and local law enforcement officers and agencies as may be reasonable and necessary for securing compliance with any reasonably necessary for securing compliance with this chapter and to take any Code Ch. 10-14-3, I have authority to emplification to the state department of health to employ any measure and give any health or local boards of health as is measure and give any
- WHEREAS, causative of disease; gatherings when considered necessary to prevent and stop epidemics further has authority to issue an order condemning or abating condit the ISDH has authority under Title 16 of the Indiana Code to forbid public authority to issue an order condemning or abating conditions
- WHEREAS, operators of retail food establishments immediately discontinue operations the ISDH and local boards of health have the authority to ensure owners or when circumstances may endanger public health;
- WHEREAS, regulatory authority over establishments the Indiana Alcohol Tobacco Commission which also provide in-dining services; and that sell alcoholic b has, beverages other things

WHEREAS, the ATC has the power to prohibit the sale of alcoholic beverages when it necessary during a time of public emergency and further has the authority violation of law; declare a public nuisance where alcoholic beverages are kept for sale H to

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Eric J. Holcomb, by virtue of the authority vested in me as Governor by the Indiana Constitution and the laws of the State of Indiana, do hereby:

- Direct the ISDH and local boards of health take all available administrative enforcement actions against establishments that provide in-dining services, including: and

- holding alcoholic beverage permits: Direct the ATC with respect to establishments permitting in-person dining and
