	During the investigation, it was determined the father, identified as the offender, had battered the child's mother and was arrested, reference EPD Case # 20-06357. The offender was transported to the Vanderburgh County Confinement Center in reference to that matter.	
	During the booking process, officers located two separate identification cards and a social security card for the name the male had not provided to officers during the arrest. A Mexico Identification Card was located, which is the name the male provided. The other card, a U.S. Permanent Resident Identification Card, was found to be fraudulent.
