The caller, a child, reported their mother and father were fighting and located outside, in front of the residence. During the investigation, it was determined the father, identified as the offender, had battered the child's mother and was arrested, reference EPD Case # 20-06357. The offender was transported to the Vanderburgh County Confinement Center in reference to that matter. During the booking process, officers located two separate identification cards and a social security card for the name the male had not provided to officers during the arrest. A Mexico Identification Card was located, which is the name the male provided. The other card, a U.S. Permanent Resident Identification Card, was found to be fraudulent. A Social Security Card, also in the same name as the fraudulent U.S. Permanent Resident Identification Card, was also found to be fraudulent. When asked about the documents, the male admitted they were fake and he used them for employment purposes. During a search of the local database, the male had provided the false name to officers during an arrest in 2016. He also provided the name during a hit and run investigation in 2016.
