Matt still has a key to the residence but forgot to bring them with him. He gained access to the house by using a credit card. Once inside the house they began discussing issues. This resulted in more of an argument and Hanna was done discussing it.

Matt leaves the house and goes out to the driveway and talks with Floyd for a few minutes. After a short discussion Floyd leaves and Matt goes into the unattached garage. Once inside the garage he starts texting Hanna. They are texting back and forth and after a few minutes he comes back up to the side door. Hanna opens the door and they began talking again. This discussion winds up in the kitchen.

After a few minutes things are not getting any better and she is trying to get Matt to leave. Matt does not want to leave but wants to keep talking about the same stuff. Hanna finally tells him that if he isn't going to leave she is going to leave. Hanna gets up from the kitchen table and walks to the back bedroom. As she is coming out of the back bedroom he blocks her path so she cannot get by. She is able to squeeze past and while doing so he grabs her phone. Hanna continues to hang onto her phone and they have a tug of war over the phone. Hanna is able to hang onto it but is being tossed around and finally gets thrown to the floor.

When Hanna was thrown to the floor she hits the back of her head on the baseboard. At this time the two pitbulls in the house are going after and biting Matt. Matt is swinging his hands and punching the pitbulls and also kicking Hanna. He was wearing work boots. One of the kicks connected to the right eye of Hanna causing swelling. In addition she also has a couple of other cuts on her face, forehead and leg. Hanna is unsure about where the cuts on her face came from but thinks the cut on her leg is from one of the dogs.

There was blood from this fight on the floor and was blood splatter on the wall near where she was being kicked. Crime Scene was called for pictures.

Hanna had ran to the neighbors house to call 911. When Officers arrived Matt had already fled from the house. Officers attempted to locate him but were unable to find him.

A relative was called and came over to the house.
