As I got closer, the vehicle very slowly began to turn to go south as well. As we continued south on Old Petersburg Rd, the driver went left of center		

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	near the McCutchanville Community United Methodist Church. He again went left of center near the Mccutchanville Volunteer Fire Department Station 5. He continued south and went left of center a third time around Mccutchanville Ct. He went left of center a final time approximately 100 yards from the stop light at Old Petersburg Rd and SR 57. Shortly after [around 50 yards further] the driver came to almost a complete stop and then sped up, running the recently changed red light. I activated my lights and initiated a traffic stop. The driver was observed to have bloodshot glossy eyes, jerky/slow movements and was very argumentative. He was asked to exit and denied any consumption of alcohol. The passenger was asked to exit and in plain view, Officer N. Hackworth observed two capsule-shaped pills in plain view in a tray near the gear shaft. The driver submitted to standardized field sobriety tests and only completed two of the test, failing both. He was placed under arrest and the vehicle was inventoried and towed by Tri-State Towing. At VCCC he submitted to a chemical test which registered .00 grams of alcohol per 210 liters of breath. He admitted to the officer administering the test that he had ingested two Xanax pills prior to being stopped.
