After much time, the male stated he was at Brother's Keeper. The male knocked on the door. A black male answered the door and stated "I will fucking kill you". The male (victim) stated the black male then stabbed him.</p> <p>Officers observed a one inch puncture wound on the male's upper left arm. There was also a fresh bruise forming underneath the puncture wound. The male had wrapped his shirt around his arm, like a tourniquet to stop the bleeding (he was success). The male also told officers the stabbing happened two or more hours prior to the male speaking to officers.</p> <p>The male had a hard time paying attention to officers, when they were attempting to get him out of handcuffs to transport him to Deaconess Mid-Town for treatment. Officers had to redirect the male's attention multiple times to get answers out of the male and to follow commands. Officers were finally able to get a set story, but the male was hesitant on going to the hospital for treatment.
