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On 05/28/2020, at approximately 09:27 hours, an Evansville Police Officer observed a silver / tan colored PT Cruiser traveling west on Pollack Avenue with a false / fictitious license plate registered to another vehicle. The vehicle was travelling quite slowly and the driver appeared concentrated on the police officer behind him.

The above vehicle turned south onto Vann Avenue and turned into a gravel parking lot of a ball field. A traffic stop was initiated and officers spoke with the driver, identified as the offender Kenneth Hyatt. Kenneth appeared anxious and had a difficult time concentrating on the officer's requests. During the traffic stop, Kenneth reported he recently purchased the vehicle and was asked for the paperwork showing such. He provided an open title to the officer and the insurance was expired. When asked about the license plate on the vehicle, Kenneth did not know who the plate belonged to at the time. When asked if he was okay with a search of the vehicle, Kenneth appeared concerned and stated it was not his vehicle, even after he had informed the officer he had recently purchased the vehicle.

When the officer returned to his vehicle to verify paperwork and finish the traffic stop, the officer observed Kenneth making numerous furtive movements within the vehicle and Kenneth appeared to grow increasingly anxious about the officer's actions. After having been instructed to stay within the vehicle, Kenneth exited the vehicle on two occasions and used excuses that did not make sense for the circumstances at hand. Kenneth was asked numerous times to stay within his vehicle.

Given the totality of the circumstances, the officer requested an additional unit for his safety and to complete the traffic stop by towing the vehicle due to the above infractions.

When an additional unit arrived on scene, Kenneth was asked to step out of the vehicle and he was hesitant to do so. It seemed as if he was thinking about his next move, but eventually agreed to exit the vehicle without any problems. When Kenneth exited the vehicle, he had been seated on an orange prescription bottle with his name "Kenneth Hyatt" printed on it. It appeared an envelope had been stuffed inside of the bottle.

In accordance with department procedures regarding a vehicle tow, the vehicle was inventoried. Other than the above prescription bottle located underneath Kenneth, a glass pipe containing burnt residue was located within the center console, it was wrapped in paper towels. The area of the center console was consistent with the area Kenneth had been observed reaching.

The envelope located within the above prescription bottle contained three (3) strips of white blotter paper. In the officer's experience, the blotter paper is used to hold narcotics such as LSD and others in order for someone to place on their skin, mouth or mucus membranes to transfer the narcotic into the bloodstream.

When asked about the strips located within the envelope, Kenneth stated the strips were used for fishing and "stink bait". He reported he purchased the strips at a local bait store. Several officers had never heard of such a thing.
