D. IN, between 11:29, 05/10/2020 and 11:33, 05/10/2020. Reported: 05/10/2020. Intimidation Threat [am] On 05/10/2020, at approximately 11:29 hours, the Evansville Police Department (EPD) was requested at 723 Hess Avenue in reference to a family dispute. The caller reported she was having problems with her son. Officers arrived on scene, spoke with the caller, identified as the victim, her father, identified as a witness, and her son, identified as the offender. It was learned the son had been released from the Vanderburgh County Confinement Center (VCCC) on work release to the victim's address due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Since being released, the victim reported her son had been disrespectful and had used narcotics. She reported the tensions had escalated to the point her son was threatening to harm her, stating he would "whoop her ass". She also reported he took her phone out of her hand as she called 9-1-1 in order to prevent the police being involved. Another officer spoke with the offender and he acknowledged he had taken his mother's phone from her as she called 9-1-1 and stated he did not believe it was a crime. He was informed by preventing someone from calling 9-1-1, it was a crime. Officers spoke with the witness, the offender's grandfather. He reported similar circumstances as the victim. He reported the offender had threatened to harm him yesterday, 05/09/2020. The victim was hesitant to pursue charges on her son, but wanted him removed from the residence. She was advised she allowed him to be placed on work release at her residence due to the COVID-19 pandemic and therefore was limited. She was advised to contact the VCCC Work Release Program and report her son's actions, along with his narcotics usage. She was advised they would likely drug test him and revoke his status if he tested positive. When the victim learned officers could not force her son to leave the residence, she decided to pursue charges. She was advised she needed to follow-up with the Vanderburgh County Prosecutor's Office once the report was submitted. The offender gathered some property and left the residence. A report was submitted to the EPD Domestic Violence Investigations Unit for follow-up. No arrests were made at time of report. HESSLER, B. D.
