Jennings continued that the argument continued to escalate and at one point she yelled at Conklin, "Fuck you!" Jennings stated Conklin the grabbed her purse and hit her in the face and pinned her down on the bed by her wrists. Jennings told me that Conklin then let her up off the bed and told her to leave. Once outside, Jennings stated she called 9-1-1.

Jennings then played an audio recording on her cell phone of the altercation. When asked about the recording, Jennings stated she began recording the "way he (Conklin) talks to me" so she could play it for her mother.

During the recording, I heard Jennings say "Fuck you!" The recording gets muffled and then I hear Conklin (who was identified on the recording by Jennings) saying why did you hit me. Conklin then tells Jennings three times to "get out" to which she responds "No" each time. Jennings stated that her phone was in her purse at the time of the recording. She also told me at one point that the phone was on the ground next to the bed and that was the reason that she was refusing to leave.

Jennings was not noted for any injuries at this time and refused medical treatment.

I then spoke to Conklin. Conklin told me that he and Jennings had been arguing all day and he agreed to bring Jennings back to his house to get her things after telling her that he didn't want her to come back. Conklin stated Jennings wanted to finish her laundry before leaving. As they were waiting for the laundry to get finished, they continued to argue.

Conklin stated at one point Jennings yells "Fuck you" and slaps him in the face. Conklin admitted to grabbing Jennings purse and throwing it down the hall, but denied aiming at Jennings or hitting her with it. Conklin added that he told Jennings several times to leave but she refused. Conklin stated he then went upstairs to get his father and waited until police arrived.

Conklin was not noted for any injuries at this time.
