Security stated he was a client, and he was driving a white Dodge truck and left north bound on Tutor Ln. at a slow rate of speed.</p> <p>Officers canvased the area was not able to locate the vehicle. Approximately ten minutes later, an officer located the subject and vehicle near Morgan Ave. parked with a subject in it. I, Officer Bond, a CIT officer, arrived and approached the driver side of the vehicle and realized it was still running. I observed a white male, later identified as IO1, in the driver`s seat yelling and screaming inside of the vehicle as he laid on his right side in a stiffing position. I was not able to get his attention, and the driver`s side door was locked. I noticed the other officer was attempting to calm him down through a partially rolled down passenger side window. The officer was attempting to get him to shut off his vehicle and unlock the door to help him. The subject continued to yell, scream, and shake while crying uncontrollably in a clear state of extreme panic. I motioned to the other officer on the passenger side to unlock the door from the inside, and he was successful. After doing so, I was able to open the door and shut the vehicle off and secure the vehicle`s keys. A machete was also secured that was laying under the driver`s seat under IO1. At that point, I attempted to gather IO1`s attention, but he continued to shake and cry stiffly on his side. Through attempted conversation with IO1, it appeared he attempted to get out, but was stiff and somewhat fell out of the truck as officers tried to slow his fall to the ground. IO1 attempted to pull himself underneath the truck but was stopped. It was found IO1 suffers from extreme PTSD and episodes of extreme panic.
