The victim stated that she has paperwork out of Vanderburgh County showing that the offender gets their 15 year old child every other Friday and that he is to be returned at 230p on Sunday. The victim advised that they normally exchange the child around 730p. The victim stated that today the offender did not make an attempt to come to Evansville to exchange the child. She stated that he never showed up at 730p and that she checked the GPS on her son's phone which showed that he was in Washington, IN. The victim advised that the suspect has a girlfriend that lives in Washington that he has been staying with. The victim also stated that he is supposed to notify her if he leaves the county with their child. She stated that their child does not have the mental capabilities to take care of himself which is another concern of hers. The victim stated that her son is missing part of his brain which causes him to not be able to read, write, etc.

The victim also informed me that the suspect has had the child since 230p this past Tuesday June 9th and has failed more than once to return him.

The victim also stated in their paperwork the suspect is not actually allowed overnights.

The victim has contacted an attorney.

The suspect called in earlier this evening and I spoke with him about custody of their son. I explained to the suspect he must follow the court order in place. The suspect stated he knew he was not suppose to keep his son but he was not going to physically remove him. The suspect also advised he did not want to give his son back because he did not want the victim to take their son to the psych ward. The suspect was advised if he did not like their court order to go back to court but until then, he must follow the order in place.

The victim was given a case number and advised on how to follow up. The victim was also advised to contact DCS if she does not feel her son is being taken care of properly.

She stated that she had parked next to a dark gray Nissan Armada which was backed in and on the passenger side of her vehicle. At approximately 1945 hours, she went to put her purse in the passenger side of the vehicle. At that time, she noticed a large scratch on the passenger side mirror. She was told by one of the coaches that the Armada belonged to an coach from another team. That information will be added to the officer narrative.

At this time, she was unsure of filing a report. She said she would attempt to make contact with the owner of the Armada at next week's game. She was advised that if she saw damage on the Armada that was consistent with her damage to safely photograph the damage. If they could not come to a resolution she was advised to contact hit and run.
