However, Andrew was still unresponsive and a third dose was requested from the Evansville Fire Department (EFD) when they arrived on scene. The third dose appeared to help and Andrew regained consciousness.

American Medical Response (AMR) Unit # 3762 arrived on scene and continued to aid Andrew before he was transported to Deaconess Midtown Hospital Emergency Room for further treatment. Due to his condition and treatment, Standard Field Sobriety Tests (SFST) were not reasonable and not conducted. Andrew's impairment was obvious. Andrew was advised of the Indiana Implied Consent Warning and consented to a chemical test. An Indiana State Police Blood Kit will be submitted for testing.

While speaking with Andrew, he admitted he had purchased narcotics, including Fentanyl, earlier in the morning. The EPD Narcotics Unit was requested due to the high toxicity of the substances. The EPD Narcotics Unit arrived a short time later, took custody of the narcotics located within the vehicle and helped inventory the vehicle prior to tow. A used syringe was located by the driver's seat within the vehicle.

The narcotics were later weighed, tested and identified as a baggy containing a methamphetamine and Fentanyl mixture. The other baggy contained Fentanyl, a Schedule II Controlled Substance.

Tri-State Towing was requested and the vehicle was towed to their yard, located at 1501 N Evans Avenue.

Once Andrew was medically cleared from the hospital, he was arrested and transported to the Vanderburgh County Confinement Center. He was charged with several crimes, including operating a motor vehicle while impaired endangering others, possession of methamphetamine, possession of Fentanyl and possession of paraphernalia.
