The victim stated she had extreme pain to her right hip, leg, and shoulder, but could not tell officers what happened at that time. Officers could see multiple abrasions all over her body from the crash. Officers then spoke with the driver of the vehicle that struck the victim. The driver stated he was driving north bound on Fulton Ave in the left hand lane with a pickup truck in front of him. A vehicle at the intersection of Florida and Fulton (by the Liquor locker), pulled out in front of him. The driver stated he then observed both vehicle stop quickly. The driver stated he attempted to stop, but quickly switched lanes to avoid hitting the vehicle in front of him. The driver stated as he switched to the right hand lane he observed a female on a bicycle crossing Fulton Ave from west to east (near the intersection of Fulton and Georgia). The male stated he slammed on his a breaks attempting to stop, but was unable to stop before hitting the female on the bicycle. Officers spoke with a witness in the parking lot of Right Stuff. The male stated he had just light up a cigarette in the parking lot of Right Stuff, when he heard tires squeal. The male stated he turned around and observed the truck in front of the suspect vehicle slam on his breaks and barely miss the female on the bicycle. The witness then observed the suspect vehicle quickly switch lanes to avoid hitting the vehicles in front of him. The witness then heard squealing of the tires and observed the suspect vehicle strike the woman on the bicycle with his vehicle. The male stated he moved the bicycle out of the way to a grassy area before 911 was called. The female was transported by AMR 0345 to Deaconess Mid-Town, where the extent of her injuries are unknown at this time. The male was transported by transport wagon to Deaconess Mid-Town, where he consented to a blood draw. Crime Scene, detectives, and crash scene reconstructionist were called to the scene. Both the vehicle and bicycle in involved were towed by Tri-State towing and placed on hold in a secured facility.
