jeans walking around the vehicles toward officers The male stated he was driving east bound on Tennessee in his Cadillac, when the pick up truck came into his lane of travel. The male stated he attempted get out of the way, but the truck would not stop. Officers asked the male where the other driver was and he stated the other driver took off.

The male was unsteady on his feet, with his jeans falling off of him. The male's belt was undone and his zipper was down, but his jeans were buttoned barely holding them around his thighs. The male used his vehicle for stability as he spoke with officers. The male made eye contact with officers, but appeared as if he was looking through them (thousand yard stare). The male's speech while clear, was slow and drawn out. The male while talking would stop leaning on the vehicle to explain what happened in the accident, but he would then quickly go back to leaning on the vehicle. The male at one point looked as if he would go into the seated position while his back was still against the vehicle.

Officers asked The male if he could pull up his jeans. The male responded with he had pain to the left side of his stomach, so that is why his pants were undone. Officers had the male walk to the driver side of the vehicle and sit in the driver seat, while officers requested AMR. As the male began walking from the passenger side of the vehicle to the driver seat, officers observed the male use the vehicle again for stability (keeping contact with his hand to the car at all times).

The male, once sitting in the driver seat, was asked if he had any medical conditions like diabetes. The male stated he did have diabetes and Asthma (the male's blue emergency inhaler was in his hand at that time). The male informed officers that he has high blood sugar, but stated he should not be having an issues at the time. The male stated he ate just prior to driving. Officers observed the male to have very enlarged pupils. The male's pupils were so enlarged officers were almost unable to see the brown in his eyes. The male's eyes also appeared to be red in color.

Once AMR arrived on scene I informed them of the male's diabetic issues. AMR checked the male's blood sugar and informed officers his blood sugar levels were where they needed to be. After AMR informed officers of the male's levels were okay, officers read the male Implied Consent. The male stated he understood the Implied Consent and he agreed to a blood draw at the hospital.

The male began to refuse AMR for further evaluation at the hospital, but began having issues with the left side of his stomach again. The male then agreed to go by ambulance to the hospital. Due to the male having pain to his stomach and not able to stand on his own, field sobriety tests (SFST) were not conducted due to safety concerns. The male was then placed in the back of the ambulance for transport to Deaconess Mid-Town.

Prior to officers following AMR to Deaconess Mid-Town, the registered owner of the truck was contacted. It was confirmed the truck was parked in front of his home. The owner's information was collected and put into the accident report.

Once at Deaconess Mid-Town, officers were informed the male told AMR EMTs he took oxycodone before driving. The male stated he has a prescription for the oxycodone. Once the male was placed in a room and officers retrieved a State Kit for the male's blood draw, officers read the male Implied Consent a second time. The male stated he understood the Implied Consent and agreed a second time to submitting to a blood draw.

Prior to the actual blood draw, the doctor began to interview the male on what happened. The male took several seconds (longer than the average person) to answer the doctor's questions. The male began falling asleep while the doctor was asking questions. The doctor made the comment that the male appeared to be impaired. Once the male heard the doctor state he was impaired, the male woke up and began answering questions. The male continued to tell officers and the doctor he was not impaired. Once the doctor left the room, the male began falling asleep again and began snoring loudly. When officers asked the nurse if the male was sleeping, he awoke and stated he was not snoring. The male stated he has severe asthma and that is "how I breath". The male then fell asleep again, continuing to snore.

The male slept most of his time in Deaconess Mid-Town awaiting presumptives for his blood work, urine, and results of his medical scans. Due to internal injuries (broken bones and tears) the male was admitted into the hospital. Preliminary results showed the male tested postive for Benzodiazepine. Charges will be filed on the male at this time.
