On 08/15/2020 at approximately 1019 hours, I, Officer R. Smith was given a notification to call the victim. While speaking to the victim, she stated that her vehicle was stolen while she was incarcerated. The victim stated that she was incarcerated in August of 2019 and was released in June of 2020. The victim stated that upon her release, she attempted to contact her apartment complex (Woodland Park Apartments) via telephone, but was unsuccessful in her attempts. The victim stated that she had attempted to reach the property manager by phone, because she was unsure if she was barred/banned from the property due to her being arrested on that same property. The victim stated that she then advised her brother to see if her vehicle was on the parking lot of the property. The victim stated that her brother advised her that her vehicle was not on the property.

The victim stated the she then went to 2340 Sunburst Blvd. (Woodland Park Apartments) and spoke with the property manager sometime in June of 2020 upon her release from jail. The victim stated that while she was incarcerated, she and the property manager had an agreement to place her personal effects from her residence, into a town home located directly behind the victim's former residence. The victim stated that the property manager advised her that her belongings had been collected by an employee of the complex and one of the victim's sons. The victim stated that she then advised the property manager that she had not received any of her belongings. The victim stated that she then asked the property manager about several vehicles left on the parking lot which were owned by the victim. The victim stated that the property manager advised her that the same employee that had gathered her items with her son, had called a tow company to remove the vehicles from the property. The victim stated that to me that it was impossible for any of her sons to help remove items from her former residence, due to the fact that both of her sons were incarcerated in January of 2020.

The victim stated that sometime in June of 2020, she observed a red 1995 Chevy Z28 convertible at 1831 S. New York Ave. The victim stated that she called the phone number related to that particular address to inquire about the vehicle. The victim stated that she went to 1831 S. New York Ave. and spoke with a male subject in regards to the vehicle. The victim stated that she asked the male subject about purchasing the vehicle, and according to the victim, the male subject advised her that he was selling parts off of the vehicle because he did not have the title to the vehicle. The victim stated that she advised the male subject that the reason he did not have the title to the vehicle was because she had the title to the vehicle and is the registered owner of the vehicle. The victim stated the male subject advised her the she could purchase the vehicle for \$800, the price he had paid for it. The victim described the male subject as a white male possibly in his late 30's to early 40's. The victim is unsure of who sold the vehicle to the male subject.

The victim stated that she had been back to 1831 S. New York Ave. on a later date to learn that her vehicle was no longer at the address. I, Officer R. Smith arrived to the address at approximately 1155 hours on today's date (08/15/2019) and did not observe the vehicle at that location.

While on the phone with the victim, she later met with me at 1301 Judson St. (Culver Family Learning Center) to show me a video of her meeting with the property manager of Woodland Parks Apartment. The video shows the victim conversing with the property manager about their agreement and the victim's inquiry of her belongings. The victim was unable to produce a title of the vehicle while on scene, but the BMV response shows her as the registered owner of the listed vehicle in this incident.
