The male is not conscious and he is snoring. Dispatch stated the caller is hysterical.</p> <p>Upon arrival, I (A. Fahse) observed Sibbitt standing in the middle of the 200 block of SE First. Sibbitt, frantically waving, directed me to her apartment. Sibbitt stated the male is back here and yelled hurry. I followed the frantic Sibbitt to the back of the home. Sibbitt stated the male is inside and upstairs as she began to open up the fence to the back gate. I asked Sibbitt why she was trying to leave and she responded with "I am trying to get their (Fire) attention". I told Sibbitt to take me to the male, later identified as John Major. I asked Sibbitt what happened and she stated "he took a hit of something".</p> <p>Sibbitt walked me through a bedroom and up a flight of stairs. As I approached the top of the stairs, I observed Major laying on his stomach. I grabbed Major by his pants and rolled him on his back. Major was unresponsive with blood coming from his mouth and his eyes were wide open. I informed dispatch that I was administering Narcan. I gave Major one dose of Narcan and still no response. I verbally attempted to get Major's attention and then took my knuckles and rubbed them aggressively on the males sternum (sternum rub) attempting pain compliance. Either of those worked. Major had a blueish grey tint to his face and I was not seeing Major's stomach or chest move up and down (not breathing). I began CPR until Fire came up the stairs and took over. Fire gave Major another dose of Narcan and began life saving measures. Major began to make a snoring sound and attempted to breath on his own, but was still unresponsive. AMR arrived a couple minutes later and both Fire and AMR worked on Major for approximately thirty or more minutes, prior to transporting Major to Deaconess Mid-Town.</p>	FAHSE, A. G.
