Although his jaw had been wired shut, he was able to communicate effectively and the reporting party assisted when it was needed.</p> <p>The incident occurred late Saturday night, 10/10/2020, into the very early morning hours of Sunday, 10/11/2020, on the parking lot of Rick`s Sports Bar, located at 1531 S Green River Road.
