	The husband reported his wife was currently at Vanderbilt for treatment in reference to a Leukemia diagnosis. He reported the business owner allowed him to place jars at several business locations to help with food and other costs incurred by his wife's treatment. He reported he arrived at the business earlier this morning to check the jar, only to realize it was missing. He and the staff reviewed surveillance footage and located the footage described above. He was understandably quite upset, reported the male suspect was possibly a frequent at the business and wanted to pursue charges against him. He knew there was at least \$30-\$50 in the jar when he last checked it a couple of days ago.	
	The surveillance footage showed the following description of the suspect. He is a white male approximately 35-45 years of age with a thin / slender build. He has short unkempt brown hair and appeared slightly unshaven in the video. His face appeared quite thin / sunken and he wore what appeared to be prescription glasses. He wore a black long sleeve shirt, light colored blue jeans and black "skater" shoes with white soles. He may frequent the business and area.	
	Although the incident was a misdemeanor since the value of the theft was less than \$750, the report will be submitted to the EPD Adult Investigations Unit for follow-up given the nature of the incident. The reasoning is due to good suspect footage and a quicker follow-up response from investigations. No arrests were made at time of this report.
