Officers made contact with the victim and it appeared he had been assaulted elsewhere. He was bleeding heavily from his head, his ears and his forehead. He had long hair, which made it difficult to determine the extent of such injuries. Officers also observed significant swelling below an eye. Officers asked the victim what had happened and he reported he was assaulted somewhere on Iowa Street, but would not disclose any further. His injuries were not sustained during the vehicle accident.

American Medical Response (AMR) was requested due to the victim's injuries he sustained prior to the vehicle accident. AMR Unit # 0535 arrived a short time later and agreed the victim needed medical attention. While being initially treated in the ambulance prior to transport, officers spoke with the victim some more. He reported the incident occurred at a location on Iowa Street. He reluctantly stated he had been looking for a girl, would not disclose who, and her boyfriend / husband found him. He made veiled comments about being bound and assaulted by more than one male. He would not deny or acknowledge if they used weapons. The victim was transported by the above AMR Unit to Deaconess Midtown Hospital Emergency Room for treatment.

During the investigation, although it could not be ruled out, officers did not have probable cause to believe the victim had operated his motor vehicle under the influence of alcohol or narcotics. Reference EPD Case # 20-19545 for additional information regarding the accident / alcohol / narcotics.

Officers followed-up with the victim at the hospital and again he refused to cooperate with the investigation. He had received sutures on his forehead and doctors were treating what appeared to be a bad wound on or within his left ear.

Officers learned through BMV records the victim had an address on E Iowa Street. Officers made contact at the residence and learned the victim had not lived / stayed there in some time. Officers were unable to follow-up with any additional leads at time of this report due to the victim`s lack of cooperation.

Given the nature of the circumstances, officers were unsure whether the victim was actually the victim of a crime, or if he had actually committed a crime and was caught. His reluctance to speak with officers about what actually occurred was suspicious. As such, officers used caution and completed a generalized report to document the victim's statements and injuries in the chance something is discovered / disclosed at a later time.
