Upon arriving, I observed a light blue Ford Focus (Indiana license plate: UFD851) with damage to the front-end on the south side of Columbia Street on the curb. I noticed the vehicle was occupied by a white female (offender). I approached the offender and began talking to her. I immediately noticed the offender's speech was slurred and her movements were very slow. The offender told me that she had been driving on Weinbach Avenue and was enroute to get cigarettes. The offender advised she did not crash her car. Since the offender was incorrect about her location, I asked her if she had taken any medication that would have impaired her. The offender openly admitted that she had taken two Xanax pills, but believed she was well enough to drive. As I was speaking to her, I noticed that she was falling asleep. I had to wake the offender up in the middle of my road-side interview. I also noticed another vehicle to the east of the offender's vehicle, a red Nissan Altima (Indiana license plate: 130TYS), had been crashed into. Another officer arrived on scene and completed an accident report.

AMR arrived for medical treatment. The offender then disclosed to AMR personnel that she had actually taken 30 Xanax pills and was trying to kill herself. Due to the nature of her intoxication, she was admitted to a local hospital. I read the offender Implied Consent, to which she consented to a chemical test. Deaconess nurses drew the offender's blood, which was submitted into evidence lockers at headquarters. Deaconess nurses also provided me with the presumptive blood results, which showed that the offender's blood was positive for the presence of Benzodiazepines (such as Xanax). The case was sent to the Prosecutor's Office for a warrant due to the offender being admitted for emergency medical treatment. The suspect began to yell, disturbing neighbors and caused them to exit their homes to see what was taking place. Officers told the suspect multiple times to be quiet, however the suspect continued to shout and yell.

Once at the jail, the suspect informed officers that he had taken illegal narcotics and consumed alcoholic beverage prior to the incident. The suspect stated that he
