He described the male wearing a work type shirt with an orange stripe on it. He then stated a man in a wheelchair was on scene trying to help the female. The caller then stated the female keyed the motorcycle and threw it on herself.

We arrived and were pointed in the direction of 815 E. Iowa. I could hear crying when we arrived inside the house. At about the same time the w/m in the shirt with the orange stripe came flying up on a bicycle. He had a knife on his right side in a pouch. He was sweating and advised us know one was at the house. At this time I placed him into handcuffs until we figured out exactly what was going on. He was upset that he was placed in handcuffs. He continued to lie about anyone being in the house. Officers yelled to check on the female several times and she didn't respond. The back door was open and at this time officers entered the residence to check on her welfare. She was hiding in the closet because she had four warrants for her arrest.

Both the male and the female denied the allegations from the neighbors. The female said she was the one causing the problem screaming and yelling. She said she threw the keys to his motorcycle. Officers didn't see any physical marks on either person. The female was arrested for her warrants. The male came outside and began screaming profanities at his neighbors. He was advised to quit screaming or he would be arrested for disorderly conduct. I advised the neighbors to call back if he continued to cause problems.

woman who works for the offender. The woman said she received that package and gave it to the offender. The victim called the offender and asked for her package. The offender denied that he had it in his possession. The victim believes the offender has the package because he is resentful toward her.

I made contact with the offender via telephone. The offender advised he is the pastor at a local church and was out volunteering all day. The offender advised he was never on the property and would be happy to buy the victim a new fire stick if it was that big of a deal. The offender also informed me of the identity of the woman who the victim met at the home, as well as her phone number.

I contacted the woman (Involved other #1) via the phone. IO#1 advised she was hired by the offender to clean the home after the victim moved out. IO#1 mentioned that she did not have the package in her possession, but remembered an unidentified person was going through the trash located on the curb of the property when she was cleaning the home. IO#1 advised the person going through the trash may have taken it.

The victim advised she wanted to press charges if she did not get her package back. The victim was provided with a case number for her reference and was advised to follow up with the Prosecutor's office.

Custody Dispute (C), at 1254 N Lincoln Park Dr, Evansville, IN, between 13:48, 11/23/2020 and 13:49, 11/23/2020. Reported: 11/23/2020. No victims listed.

Officers were dispatched to 1254 N Lincoln Park Dr in reference to a standy for a child custody dispute at 1415 hours and arrived at 1426 hours. When Officers arrived the father was waiting outside the mother's residence with a court order stating that he is allowed to see his children but their mother is denying his rights. The father stated that he has not seen the children in two weeks and that he has repeatedly sent messages to their mother asking when he can come by and see them. At this time the court order is for their older child but they have not yet got a custody aggreement on the younger child. The father said that he has driven by the house to see if the mother was home. On one occasion he saw her out by the garage and when she noticed that he was at the residence she ran inside and would not answer the door. The father stated that he did have sole custody at one point in time but DCS had let the children go back and stay with the mother.

Officers viewed the custody arrangement and verified its authenticity. The order was issued out of Warrick County and stated that the father can see the children "after work".

When Officers talked to the mother she stated that she did not trust that her children were safe with the father. When the mother had talked to her lawyer she said that he advised her not to let the children go with their father until a new child custody order was written. The mother told Officers that she wanted to get a harrassment report filed on the father. She said that just today she had gotten 5 phonecalls from different phone numbers which she claimed were the father trying to contact her. She also provided about 10 text messages in the past 3 days all from the father. Officer looked at text messages and all were in reference to the father requesting when he would be able to see the kids.
