The victim turned right onto Oak Grove and into a gravel parking lot where he convinced the victim to get into his vehicle to go to his mothers house so she could witness the exchange. The suspect then drove off with the victim inside and this is when the victim first saw the handgun in the console. As the suspect drove away, he laughed and told the victim that he wasn't't going to his mothers, but was going to kill her. As they approached the intersection of Morgan and Cross Pointe Blvd the suspect struck her in the face with his elbow and continued striking her in the face and head. The victim attempted to exit the vehicle as he turned eastbound onto Morgan grabbing her hair and pulling her back into the vehicle. She managed to slip out of her jacket and exit the vehicle running down a ditch southbound onto the railroad tracks. She was yelling for help when the suspect exited the vehicle as though he was going to pursue her, so she crossed a ditch full of water estimated to be 3 feet deep by the victim and ran over to the Caseys Gas Station for help. The suspect drove away throwing her phone out the passenger window of the vehicle possibly into the water. A Caseys employee, Bonnie Harvey, came to her assistance calling 911 for help. The phone or shoes of the victim have yet to be located. AMR arrived on scene and transported the victim to Deaconess Gateway for examination. Det. Hamner took photographs of the victim prior to being transported and Det. M.Bow also spoke with her on scene. The children and her unidentified friend were unable to be located at this time. I later was notified by records that the Auto Theft report requested by the victim initially on 11-21-20 was completed. The victim had very little information on the vehicle in that her purchase papers were still in the glovebox of the purchased vehicle. Records was notified of this report. Sgt Taylor later advised me that the children were located and released to the paternal father. Cross reference this case with 20-21131. End
