The caller reported the incident possibly originated at apartment # 716.</p> <p>Officers arrived on scene, did not locate anyone in the hallway and made contact at apartment # 716 with a black male, identified as the victim. He reported the offenders left prior to their arrival. He reported two acquaintances, both identified as offenders, had been intermittently at his apartment for some time. During a recent incident, the victim reported the male offender disrespected him and he told him they could "throw hands" the next time they were around each other.</p> <p>The victim admitted he called the male and female offenders to his apartment, allowed them into the building and when they knocked on his apartment door, there was an altercation in the hallway stemming from the previous incident. They victim reported while he and the male offender were mutually fighting in the hallway, the female offender, who had been allowed to stay at the residence previously, entered his apartment and reportedly stole the victim's black / light blue colored cellular phone, valued at a few hundred dollars. The victim was unaware his phone had been stolen until the situation calmed.</p> <p>The victim reportedly entered his residence while the male offender was still in the hallway, upset from the fight. Moments later, the victim reported the male offender kicked his door after he had been hitting the walls in the hallway of the building. When the male offender kicked the door, it broke the door jamb and the door's ability to secure itself. Damage was valued at a couple of hundred dollars to repair / replace.</p> <p>In brief, the victim reported he had allowed the two offenders to previously stay at the apartment, invited them over this morning and engaged in a mutual fight stemming from a previous incident. At some point, unbeknown to the victim, the female offender entered his unlocked apartment and reportedly stole the victim's phone while he continued to fight in the hallway with the male offender. Only after the victim returned to his apartment did the male offender kick the victim's door, breaking the door along with the door jamb. There were signs of damage in the hallway from their altercation. Given the totality of the circumstances, the offenders did not break into the victim's apartment to commit a felony or theft, but rather were invited to the property to fight. It was only during this time did the opportunity to commit theft present itself and the female offender took the victim's phone.
